FAQ's

Is the event rain or shine?

Yes. If there is a change to the schedule, we will post the information on the [homepage of the Plane Pull Web site](#). **Team Registration and the vendor booths will open at 9:00 a.m. and the Plane Pull will begin at 11:00 a.m.**

What IS the actual Plane Pull?

The Plane Pull is a fun team competition to see who can pull a 164,000+ airplane the fastest. Teams are made up of up to 25 members, who line up adjacent to a huge rope attached to the aircraft. The starter signals when to start and starts the stopwatch. After the team pulls the aircraft 12 feet, the stopwatch stops and the elapsed time is recorded as the team score. Each team is then weighed (as a group) and assembles to have their team photo taken.

Who can participate?

The Plane Pull is a team competition, so gather 24 of your coworkers, friends or family members (teams are made up of 25 people) and start lifting those weights! The Plane Pull is open to corporate groups, service organizations, churches and school groups – anyone who can organize a group and get people motivated to try something new and fun!

Please note- you do not need all 25 to participate. We will have volunteer pullers there who can step in and help you pull if you do not have 25 on your team.

What is the minimum donation?

Teams must raise a minimum of \$1,250, or \$50 per team member. Many corporate groups are sponsored by their companies, and/or team members raise pledges to cover the team fee. Fundraising is easy using our online fundraising tool.

What if our team doesn't raise \$1,250?

In order for your team to be eligible to pull, you must have raised at least \$1,250 by event day (August 4). If you do not reach the minimum, you will not be permitted to pull. The donations you received will not be refunded and will go to support the mission of Special Olympics Colorado. If you would like to ensure your team's participation at the event you can authorize Special Olympics Colorado to charge a team member's credit card for the amount equal to the difference of what you raise by event day, up to the \$1,250 minimum requirement.

Where & what time is the Plane Pull?

The Plane Pull will be held from 11:00 a.m. – approximately 2:00 p.m. (until the last team pulls) at

Signature Flight Support at Denver International Airport. Registration will be open from 9:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m.

What about bringing my family, friends and pets to cheer me on?

Bring your family, friends and coworkers to see you pull, but please leave your pets at home. Animals – unless they're service dogs – are not allowed on the tarmac, and don't appreciate the loud airplane noises anyway (the Plane Pull site is adjacent to an operating runway). Please note that all participants and spectators will be asked to go through a metal detector prior to entering the event site.

How do we get there?

The event will take place at the Signature Airport which is located at the Denver International Airport. The address is: 7850 Harry B. Combs Parkway, Denver, CO 80249

Directions from I-70

- Exit I-70 onto Peña Boulevard (signs for Peña Boulevard/Denver International Airport)
- Take the exit toward Terminal East
- Keep right at the form and continue toward E 80th Avenue
- Turn left onto E. 80th Avenue
- Take the 1st right onto Harry B Combs Parkway
- Destination will be on the left

Where do we park?

Ample free parking is available on the airport grounds. Look for the Plane Pull parking signs.
